

Cemetery – Memorial Day Guidelines

As Memorial Day is less than a month away, the City of Lamar is providing Cemetery Guidelines for visitation, at our cemeteries, so that families who lost loved ones can properly plan for their visitation.

Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE), has issued guidance to follow related to Funeral Homes, Crematoriums, and CEMETERIES. Issued pursuant to executive order of the Governor D 2020 044, Public Health Order 20-28, Safer at Home provides the following guidance:

Appendix F: Critical Businesses

- A. Must comply with the guidance and directives issued by the CDPHE and must comply with Social Distancing Requirements.
- B. Part 5. Critical Services – Funeral Homes, Crematories, and Cemeteries with strict compliance with Social Distancing requirements for employees and any attendees of services.
- C. As this Public Health Order relates strictly to cemeteries, families will need to comply with social distancing requirements and generally remain 6' apart and should not gather in groups of more than 10 individuals. Families are encouraged to stagger visitation for larger groups.
