CITY OF LAMAR BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS MEETING MINUTES November 22, 2022

Please review the attached meeting minutes from September 29, 2022. I will need to have approval for them. Rich and Todd have approved.

Last night Rich Maggart, Todd Horning, and Craig Brooks were in attendance. We did not meet a quorum so we will have a discussion via email and then I will call for a phone poll.

First up was discussion on AA2022-08 Robbie Sue Young's request to put up a 9' fence between her and the neighbor. The property in question is located along the canal. There are no roads or any other homes that the fence would affect. She did get two signatures from the neighbors. Please see attached drawing. The reason she wants to put up the fence is that the property is up for sale. She was hoping to purchase the trailer and property but her offer was not accepted. She is worried about new neighbors because her home and deck sit higher and she can see into their yard.

A 9' fence is higher than any fence in Lamar. There have been a couple of fences approved at 8'. The biggest question was what type of fence does she plan on putting in and that is must be put in securely. I have spoke with Robbie Sue and she plans on putting up a wood fence with metal posts. She has spoken to a couple of people about construction as she knows the importance of it being structurally sound. She is still hopeful she will be able to purchase the property and then it will be a moot point. The plan for the fence sounds doable.

There was discussion on AA2022-09 Alfonso Holguin as well. It was discussed that building a home out of shipping containers is not a conventional method. When something is not a conventional method than there must be full engineering plans in place. There is currently nothing in the Lamar Municipal Code regarding shipping containers. Todd also brought up that shipping containers when new have a 25-year life. This might be something that Alfonso had not considered which brings us back to the importance of engineered plans for this type of project. System Operating Report

Superintendent Hourieh reported that the wind turbines generation data for 2022 showed that Lamar's three wind turbines have generated 12,557.74 MWH's of electricity. This is about 1.46% lower than what was generated in 2021. The turbines have an average capacity factor of 31.37% which is lower than last year by about 0.27%. Since installation of the wind turbines in 2003, 2010 was the best year followed by 2008, and the third best year was 2020.

Superintendent Hourieh reported that with Auxilus Renewables on site, the wind turbine crew completed replacing the oil on the yaw drives of all wind turbines. Each turbine has 4 yaw drives that holds about 5 gallons of gearbox oil.

Superintendent Hourieh reported that the line crew has completed the installation of a 3 phase, 277/480v new service to a 40 hp irrigation sprinkler located at Rd 1 and Rd NN in Prowers County. The crew also replaced a decayed power pole to the east of Main and Washington St. The newly installed 45 ft. steel pole is on the Northside 4kv circuit.

Superintendent Hourieh reported that CAMU has provided a list of House Bills and Senate Bills that could have some effect on us. He did a quick review of those that there were concerns with.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Boardmember Brooke moved and Boardmember Leonard seconded that the meeting adjourn.



STAFF INFORMATION SOURCE: City Clerk and Police Chief

BACKGROUND:

Walmart Inc., owner of the Walmart #2672, has made application for the liquor license modification of premise located at 1432 E. Olive St., Lamar, Colorado. They would like to add additional shelving and refrigeration to their current location.

They will be adding new sections to current location to provide room for the addition of wine to their location.

44-3-311 states that the local licensing authority shall schedule a public hearing upon the application not less than thirty days from the date of the application and shall post and publish the public notice thereof not less than ten days prior to such hearing. Public notice shall be given by the posting of a sign in a conspicuous place on the premises for which application has been made and by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the premises are located.

At the February 27, 2023 City Council meeting, a public hearing date of March 13, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. was scheduled for the Modification of Premise to their current FMB liquor license. Public notice for the hearing and the procedure for protesting same was conspicuously posted at the site by the City on or before March 2, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION: In the absence of any valid protests, Police Chief Miller will be recommending that the Modification of Premise to the FMB Liquor License under the name Walmart Inc. dba/Walmart #2672 be approved.



BACKGROUND:

Safeway Stores 46 Inc., owner of Safeway #1721, has made application for the liquor license modification of premise located at 906 E. Olive St., Lamar, Colorado. They would like to add additional shelving and refrigeration to their current location.

They will be adding new sections to current location to provide room for the addition of wine to their location.

44-3-311 states that the local licensing authority shall schedule a public hearing upon the application not less than thirty days from the date of the application and shall post and publish the public notice thereof not less than ten days prior to such hearing. Public notice shall be given by the posting of a sign in a conspicuous place on the premises for which application has been made and by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the premises are located.

At the February 27, 2023 City Council meeting, a public hearing date of March 13, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. was scheduled for the Modification of Premise to their current FMB liquor license. Public notice for the hearing and the procedure for protesting same was conspicuously posted at the site by the City on or before March 2, 2023.

RECOMMENDATION: In the absence of any valid protests, Police Chief Miller will be recommending that the Modification of Premise to the FMB Liquor License under the name Safeway Stores 46 Inc./dba Safeway Store #1721 be approved.



BACKGROUND: On February 13, 2023 the Colorado Attorney General's Office sent out an email to the participating local governments concerning a new settlement with five opioid companies. The five companies which reached a settlement with the Colorado Attorney General's Office are Allergan, CVS, TEVA, Walgreens, Walmart. The funding which the city would receive will go to Region 19, which Lamar is part of.

On July 11, 2022 the City of Lamar opted-out of receiving the fund from the prior settlements and this opt-out automatically carries over to this new settlement.

RECOMMENDATION:

Motion to approve the participation in the settlements with the five companies and allow the Mayor to sign.

- 2. Following the execution of this Settlement Participation Form, the Governmental Entity shall comply with Section III.B of the Teva Settlement regarding Cessation of Litigation Activities.
- 3. The Governmental Entity shall, within 14 days of the Reference Date and prior to the filing of the Consent Judgment, file a request to dismiss with prejudice any Released Claims that it has filed. With respect to any Released Claims pending in In re National Prescription Opiate Litigation, MDL No. 2804, the Governmental Entity authorizes the Plaintiffs' Executive Committee to execute and file on behalf of the Governmental Entity a Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice substantially in the form found at https://nationalopioidsettlement.com.
- 4. The Governmental Entity agrees to the terms of the Teva Settlement pertaining to Subdivisions as defined therein.
- 5. By agreeing to the terms of the Teva Settlement and becoming a Releasor, the Governmental Entity is entitled to the benefits provided therein, including, if applicable, monetary payments beginning after the Effective Date.
- 6. The Governmental Entity agrees to use any monies it receives through the Teva Settlement solely for the purposes provided therein.
- 7. The Governmental Entity submits to the jurisdiction of the court in the Governmental Entity's state where the Consent Judgment is filed for purposes limited to that court's role as provided in, and for resolving disputes to the extent provided in, the Teva Settlement.



- 8. The Governmental Entity has the right to enforce the Teva Settlement as provided therein.
- 9. The Governmental Entity, as a Participating Subdivision or Participating Special District, hereby becomes a Releasor for all purposes in the Teva Settlement, including but not limited to all provisions of Section V (Release), and along with all departments, agencies, divisions, boards, commissions, districts, instrumentalities of any kind and attorneys, and any person in their official capacity elected or appointed to serve any of the foregoing and any agency, person, or other entity claiming by or through any of the foregoing, and any other entity identified in the definition of Releasor, provides for a release to the fullest extent of its authority. As a Releasor, the Governmental Entity hereby absolutely, unconditionally, and irrevocably covenants not to bring, file, or claim, or to cause, assist or permit to be brought, filed, or claimed, or to otherwise seek to establish liability for any Released Claims against any Released Entity in any forum whatsoever. The releases provided for in the Teva Settlement are intended by Released Entitles and the Governmental Entity to be broad and shall be interpreted so as to give the Released Entities the broadest possible bar against any liability relating in any way to Released Claims and extend to the full extent of the power of the Governmental Entity to release claims. The Teva Settlement shall be a complete bar to any Released Claim.
- 10. The Governmental Entity hereby takes on all rights and obligations of a Participating Subdivision or Participating Special District as set forth in the Teva Settlement.
- 11. In connection with the releases provided for in the Teva Settlement, each Governmental Entity expressly waives, releases, and forever discharges any and all provisions, rights, and benefits conferred by any law of any state or territory of the United States or other jurisdiction, or principle of common law, which is similar, comparable, or equivalent to § 1542 of the California Civil Code, which reads:

General Release; extent. A general release does not extend to claims that the creditor or releasing party does not know or suspect to exist in his or her favor at the time of executing the release that, if known by him or her, would have materially affected his or her settlement with the debtor or released party.

A Releasor may hereafter discover facts other than or different from those which it knows, believes, or assumes to be true with respect to the Released Claims, but each Governmental Entity hereby expressly waives and fully, finally, and forever settles, releases and discharges, upon the Effective Date, any and all Released Claims that may exist as of such date but which Releasors do not know or suspect to exist, whether through ignorance, oversight, error, negligence or through no fault whatsoever, and which, if known, would materially affect the Governmental Entities' decision to participate in the Teva Settlement.

12. Nothing herein is intended to modify in any way the terms of the Teva Settlement, to which Governmental Entity hereby agrees. To the extent this Election and Release is interpreted differently from the Teva Settlement in any respect, the Teva Settlement controls.
