- 3.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS. In consideration of the mutual covenants and promises of the Parties contained herein, and other valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as set forth in this Agreement. The parties further agree that Scooters will construct, operate and open to the public a coffee shop, and that if said event occurs Scooters will receive the Incentive Agreement described in Section 4.0, and if does not, this Agreement will terminate.
- 4.0 INCENTIVE. This Development Incentive is designed as a post-performance incentive and as such shall be calculated based upon the actual increase in sales tax receipts received by the City of Lamar in the period following the redevelopment of Scooters' Property located at 1231 North Main Street in Lamar. Upon completion of Scooters' building, operation and the building being open to the public, the City agrees as follows:
  - A.01 INCENTIVE CALCULATION AND AWARD. The Projected Base Period for the calculation shall be the projected sales and property tax the City would receive based on the average of the sales and property taxes received by the City of Lamar from a similar sized coffee shop in the area for the previous three (3) calendar years 2020, 2019, and 2018. The Projected Base Period Average for the City's sale tax that the City would receive for the next five (5) years is: \$5,748.00. The Projected Base Period Average for the County's property tax that the City would receive for the next five (5) years is: \$3,557.42. Upon Scooters providing the necessary and satisfactory proof to the City, the economic incentive provided annually to Scooters shall be structured as follows:
    - a) The First Incentive Year shall begin on January 1, 2021 and shall run through December 31, 2021. Scooters will be provided a sales and property tax remittance in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the City's sales tax and one hundred percent (100%) of the City's portion of property tax generated from Scooters during the First Incentive Year.
    - b) The Second Incentive Year shall begin on January 1, 2022 and shall run through December 31, 2022. Scooters will be provided a sales and property tax remittance in the amount of eighty percent (80%) of the City's sales tax and eighty percent (80%) of the City's portion of property tax generated from Scooters during the Second Incentive Year.
      - c) The Third Incentive Year shall begin on January 1, 2023 and shall run through December 31, 2023. Scooters will be provided a sales and property tax remittance in the amount of sixty percent (60%) of the City's sales tax and sixty percent (60%) of the City's portion of property tax generated from Scooters during the Third Incentive Year.

#### December 2022 Financial Report

Superintendent Hourieh reviewed the December 2022 financials which included the following:

Balance Sheet - Cash is up \$182,174.00 from November 2022 and accounts receivable has increased by \$114,216.00.

Income Statement – Total operating revenue is \$1,100,986.00 with total operating costs being \$1,001,767.00 for a gross operating income of \$99,219.00. Adding in non-operating revenues and expenses brings the net income to \$391,692.00.

YTD Income Statement – YTD operating revenue is \$14,205,830.00 and total operating costs are \$12,836,576.00 resulting in gross operating income of \$1,369,254.00. Adding in non-operating revenues and expenses, there is a net income of \$81,762.00.

YTD Comparison to 2021 – Retail sales are up \$171,378.00 or 1%. However, operating expenses are up approximately \$667,333.00 or 5% resulting in a net income of \$81,762.00 for the year.

System Operating Report

Superintendent Hourieh reported that the line and metering crews completed the installation of the wind turbines metering equipment per Tri-State G&T requirements. Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System (WREGIS) has requested that all load-serving entities track and report their renewable energy generation in real time using SCADA equipment. Tri-State G&T will track and report wind energy production to WREGIS and to the Balancing Authority of this area, Excel Energy. This process will enable LUB and ARPA to market the Renewable Energy Certificates (REC's) generated by the wind turbines.

Superintendent Hourieh reported that the wind turbine crew will be starting the semiannual maintenance and inspection program on all five wind turbines. Each turbine will be shut down for approximately 8 hours on a calm day so that preventative maintenance can be performed safely per GE's recommended maintenance program.

Superintendent Hourieh also reported that the line crew completed construction of a new service to the announcing booth and scoreboard at Escondido Park.

Superintendent Hourieh announced that he was able to find 7 re-manufactured transformers through a company called Hi to Low Voltage. They are a cost of \$4,500.00 per transformer or \$31,500.00 total.

Boardmember Stagner moved and Boardmember Brooke seconded to approve the purchase of 7 re-manufactured transformers from Hi to Low Voltage in the amount of \$31,500.00.



#### SALES/USE TAX REVENUE COMPARISON BY CATEGORY



Each copy or certificate shall contain a valid provision or endorsement that the policy may not be canceled, terminated, or modified without giving thirty (30) day's written notice to City.

A renewal policy shall be delivered to the City at least ten (10) days prior to a policy's expiration date except for any policy expiring on or after the expiration date of this agreement.

The parking availability for the new Escondido soccer fields is limited and access to the park is restricted on the South side. Joe Zavala owns the property connecting the fields to the South and has agreed to sell to the City of Lamar.

This will ease congestion, expand parking and possibility of additional future amenities at the park.

**RECOMMENDATION**: Approve the purchase of the land from Joe Zavala.

### SECTION ONE PROPERTY SOLD; PRICE; PAYMENT

That Seller shall sell to Buyer and Buyer shall purchase from Seller the following described real property situated in the County of Prowers and State of Colorado, to-wit:

Lots ten (10), eleven (11), twelve (12) and thirteen (13) in Block 3 of Moore's Subdivision of Lot five (5) in Forest Park Place Subdivision to the City of Lamar, According to the Recorded Plat Thereof, City of Lamar, Colorado 81052, County of Prowers.

(the "Property")

Buyer shall pay Seller a total purchase price of Twenty Thousand and no/100 Dollars (\$20,000.00) Payable as follows, to wit:

- a. SECTION THREE TITLE INSURANCE Seller and Buyer shall split the costs of purchasing a title insurance commitment certificate to a date no earlier than the date of said Purchase Agreement showing good and merchantable title in fee simple, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except for any and all oil, gas and other mineral reservations of record, existing easements or rights of way for roads, pipelines, telephone and electric lines and other utilities, and to the burdens of special districts and similar restrictions, and as to taxes assessed for the year 2022 and subsequent years. Said title insurance commitment will be ordered from Bison Title Company of Lamar, Colorado after execution of said Agreement and shall be furnished to Buyer as soon as it is available.

# SECTION FOUR TITLE EXAMINATION

Buyer shall have a reasonable time in which to examine said title commitment or abstract of title and to notify Seller of any title defects or requirements. If no notice of such defects is received within ten (10) days, then the title shall be deemed merchantable. Notice of any reasonable title requirements to be made shall be given in writing by Buyer to Seller, and Seller shall have a reasonable time to cure the same, not to exceed thirty (30) days. However, if such title requirements cannot be cured before the Closing or within a reasonable period of time, Buyer may elect to accept such title as Seller may convey or to otherwise terminate this Agreement without damages to either party. # SECTION SIX "AS IS" PURCHASE

Except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, Buyer specifically acknowledges that Buyer is purchasing the Property in its "AS IS", condition and further acknowledges and agrees that, except as expressly contained in this Purchase Agreement, neither Seller nor anyone acting for or on behalf of Seller has made any representations, statements, warranties, or promises to Buyer concerning the physical aspects and conditions of any of the improvements upon the aforementioned real property, the availability of changes in zoning or permitted uses, the availability of water for irrigation or otherwise for any of the Property, any dimensions or specifications of any of the Property, the acreage of the Property, the feasibility or desirability of any of the Property for a particular use, any projected income or expenses for any of the Property. Buyer is purchasing the aforementioned real property after being afforded a right to inspection and

examination, in an "AS IS" state of repair. Buyer shall execute a General Warranty Deed at the time of closing.

# SECTION SEVEN CLOSING DATE/POSSESSION

This Purchase Agreement shall be closed at a time mutually convenient to both parties on or before May 31, 2021. # SECTION TEN DAMAGE TO PROPERTY

In the event the Property is damaged by fire or casualty prior to closing, the Buyer may elect that the insurance proceeds be used to repair or restore the Property and this Purchase Agreement shall continue, unless the damages exceed the purchase price under this Agreement, in which event, this Agreement may be terminated at the option of the Buyer and all payments and things of value received hereunder shall be returned to Buyer. In addition to all remedies provided for by law in the event of any dispute regarding the terms or enforcement to any provision in this Purchase Agreement, the successful party shall be awarded its costs and reasonable attorney's fees against the unsuccessful party, including those fees and costs incurred in any arbitration, litigation or appeal of such dispute.

# SECTION THIRTEEN SURVEYS, INSPECTIONS AND COSTS

In the event Buyer desires any inspections or surveys, such costs shall be Buyer's sole responsibility and expense. Buyer shall be responsible for the payment of all costs relating to any survey or other inspection incurred by Buyer. Buyer shall notify the Seller of any defects resulting from any survey or inspection, and Seller shall have a reasonable period of time to cure any defects.
