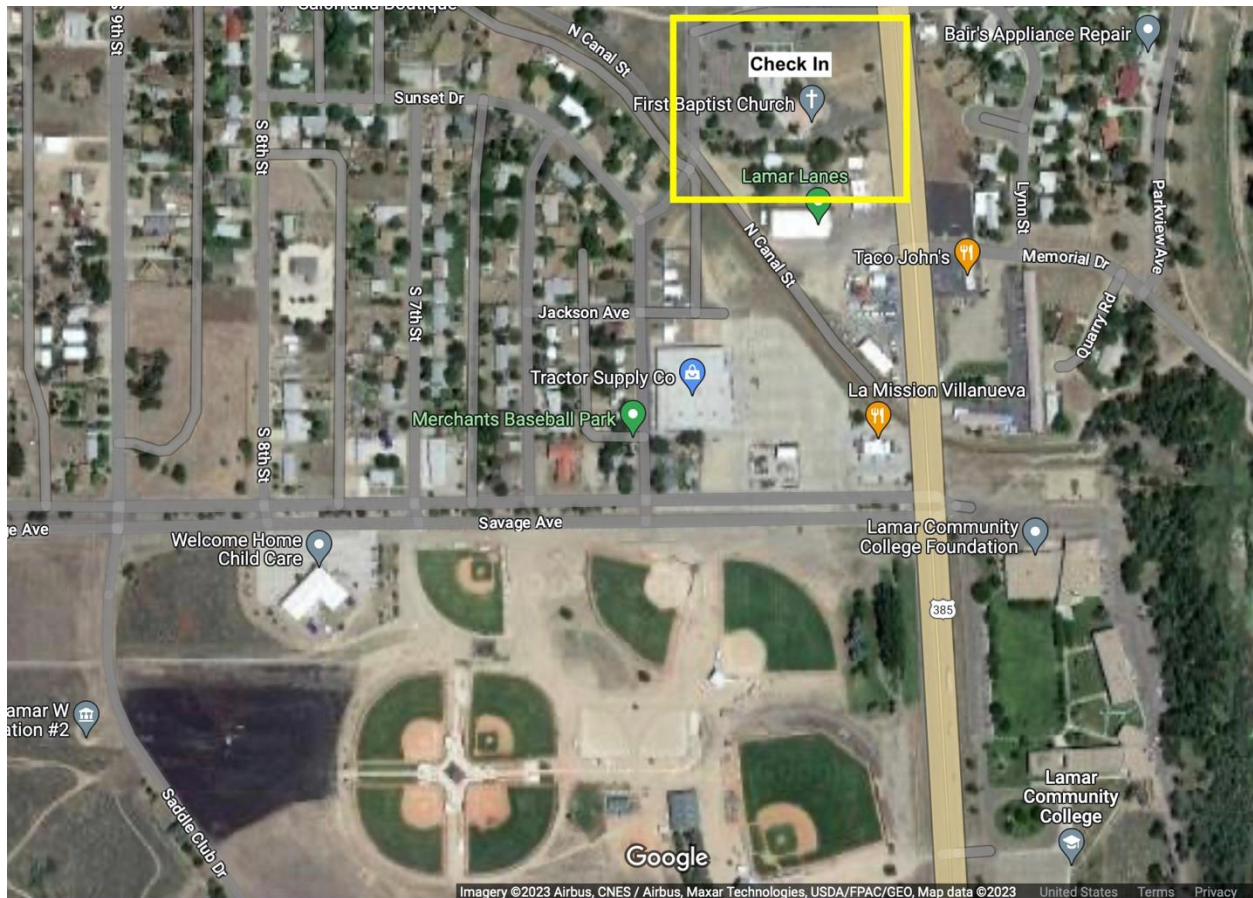

Latest Rule Changes for 2023

The International Board of Directors has approved the following rule changes beginning with the 2023 season. These changes will be reflected in the 2023 Babe Ruth League, Inc. Rules and Regulations.

Rule Changes Beginning with the 2023 Season (Please note Division or Level of Play)

Cal Ripken Baseball, League Age 9, 10, Tournament Regulations - Rule 11.05, Paragraph 4(b) – A pitcher shall not deliver more than 75 pitches in the same game or on the same day.

Cal Ripken Baseball, League Age 11, 12, Tournament Regulations - Rule 11.05, Paragraph 4(c) – A pitcher shall not deliver more than 85 pitches in the same game or on the same day.

Babe Ruth Baseball, League Age 13-15, Tournament Regulations - Rule 11.05, Paragraph 4(d) – A pitcher shall not deliver more than 95 pitches in the same game or on the same day.

Cal Ripken Baseball Division, Babe Ruth Baseball Division, Babe Ruth Softball Division, Babe Ruth Buddy Ball Division - Jewelry is permitted in all divisions of Babe Ruth League Inc. Umpires have the authority to remove anything believed to distract or increase risk to player safety. Medical alert or religious bracelets or necklaces are not considered jewelry.”

PRIORITIES

- Email a high-quality team picture and roster to the Tournament Director.

 - Please use JPEG format so it can be used on our ONLINE program.
- Find your team check-in time and coordinate travel. All teams must check in at their designated time unless previous arrangements are approved by the Tournament Director and State Commissioner. All team members, including coaches and manager, must be present at check in.
- Ensure you have your entire team's tournament credentials organized. A complete list of requirements is on the next page.

Tournament Book Credentials

Be sure to include the following in your Tournament Book;

1. Letter of Eligibility signed by the State Commissioner
2. Tournament Team Roster signed by League President
3. Coaches Abuse Prevention Certificate for all Coaches and Manager
4. Babe Ruth Coach Certification for all Coaches and Manager
5. Concussion Training Certificate for all Coaches and Manager
6. Certificate of Insurance for Liability and Accident
7. Insurance Claim Form signed by League Official and undated
8. Consent for Treatment form with original signature for all players and batboys
9. Team photo with players information
10. Copy of Waivers (if applicable)

The following may help in assembling and organizing your Tournament Book

How to Assemble Your Tournament Credentials

Step 1

Access your account at BabeRuthLeague.org. Your league president or appointed officer will be able to help you with gaining access to your account.



Step 2

Start your Credentials book by using a 1/2" ring binder that you can find in an office supply store.

Step 3

Place clear sheet protectors for the documents inside the binder.



Step 4

Insert your league's LOE (Letter of Eligibility). This is approved by your State Commissioner and available once approved for printing from your League Portal. If you don't have the option to print the LOE, contact your State Commissioner. Commissioners will not be able to approve LOE's until after June 5th of each year. See LOE section for step-by-step instructions on obtaining your LOE.



Step 5

Insert a copy of your tournament team roster in the binder. If you have any Add/Drops that are made on your tournament roster after June 30th, please

be sure to put the revised approved roster in front, keeping the original roster in the binder. **Quick Note:** You must have an official, submitted roster from your league's affiliated SportsEngine HQ site. Only Add/Drops accompanied by a letter from Headquarters giving specific approval will be valid. Also, per Rule 11.02b, "Players, manager, and coaches may be replaced between tournament levels, but a league may not add players after submitting a team roster at the first level of tournament play. Babe Ruth League strongly recommends each league take a full roster of players into tournament competition."

Step 6

Insert a copy of your league's Certificate of Insurance for Accident and Liability Insurance. If you have Babe Ruth insurance and your league took both Accident and Liability coverage with Babe Ruth, they will both appear together on the certificate form.



Step 7

Insert Consent for Treatment forms. You can print out Treatment Forms from the Babe Ruth Website!



Quick Note: Be sure to have 1 Consent form for each player on the roster. The Consent for Treatment form can be found under Resources > Forms at BabeRuthLeague.org.

Step 9

Place Certificates of Certification for each manager and coach that has successfully completed the Coaches Certification Program into your binder.

Quick Note: Visit www.baberuthcoaching.org for information on how you can enroll in this superb training program.

Step 10

Managers and coaches are not required to submit a paper copy of their APS certification, as it is addressed in the Eligibility requirement to submit rosters to Babe Ruth League via their affiliated SportsEngine HQ site.

Step 11 - Check List

- Did I order Official Emblems or the Cap Emblem option for my players and coaches?
- Do I want to order District, State or Regional Champion and Runner-Up Pins?
- Does my team have the schedule for games as well as the contact numbers for the host league and tournament director?
- Do my team managers and coaches have rule books?



Step 8

Place a printed copy of your team photo, in uniform, in your binder. Please remember that this photo may also be used for program books and other publications as you advance in the tournament trail. Make sure to have a good photo taken.

Managers-Coaches-Teams

Thank you for all you do and the time you commit. Listed below are a few items to keep in mind and a reminder for your players and spectators.

Check-In

All credentials are required upon check-in. Please reference the beginning of this book for a list of requirements for your Tournament Book. Please check-in at your designated time as a team and have team in uniform shirts.

Concussion Training

We would like to remind you of the coach concussion training that is required by

Colorado state law.

Schedule

Please always adhere to the schedule. Provide line-up cards to public address booth 30 minutes prior to game. There will be no infield warmup prior to the game. There is a field adjacent to the complex that will be available as a practice field.

Uniforms

All players AND COACHES must be in full uniform for all games and Opening Ceremony. Coaches MUST have uniform pants; NO SHORTS, no exceptions. Uniforms must meet all Babe Ruth/Cal Ripken uniform requirements, including the shoulder patch.

Umpires

There will be certified umpires for each game. Care has been taken to have officials with experience. It is expected they be treated as such. Only the manager is to address the umpires to discuss controversial plays. Do not allow players or assistant coaches to address umpires. The umpire-in-chief will be aware of the identity of each team manager.

Awards

Medals and/or plaques will be awarded for first and second place.

GameChanger App

All of the scheduled games during the State Tournament will be recorded on the GameChanger App. Go ahead and download the app on your smart phone.

***Team scorers GameChanger training sessions will be available prior to the tournament and in person at the tournament. The week of the tournament (between the 2nd of July through the 5th of July) will be done via Zoom, Teams, or other. There will be an in-person session likely Thursday night in Lamar. Specific dates and times will be communicated soon.

This training will go over most everything scorers will need to properly score a game. Even experienced scorekeepers will learn something new, so every team should have at least one scorekeeper attend.

Additional Information

Gate Admission:

There will not be a daily gate fee but a team spectator fee of \$450.

Pre-Game Information:

There will be no infield warmup prior to games. Infield warm ups will be allowed only on the practice dirt infield west of the baseball fields. Teams entering to play may play catch in the outfield. Teams in the first base dugout can use right field (play catch East-West) and teams in third base dugout can use left field (play catch North-South). Pitchers and catchers may use the bullpens. Per Babe Ruth rules, catchers must be in full gear when catching, even if it is only warm-ups. Home team shall use the third base dugout and visitors shall use the first base dugout. Be ready to play. Turn line-ups into official scorekeepers 30 minutes prior to game time. Scorekeepers will be located in the crow's nest in the middle of the Four-Plex

Line-ups:

Ensure that your lineup is filled out correctly before presenting it to the official scorekeeper 30 minutes prior to your scheduled game time. Line-up cards should be 4-part: with one copy going to the official scorekeeper, one copy for the umpire, one copy for your opponent, and one copy for your use. **Please include FIRST and LAST names, jersey number, and position played.**

Game Conduct

1. Umpires will enforce all rules and regulations covered in the Official Baseball Rules and the Babe Ruth Rules and Regulations.
2. The games will be kept moving at all times. No unnecessary delays will be allowed. Mound conferences should be kept to a minimum.
3. ANYONE-Players, manager or coaches-acting in an unsportsmanlike manner will be removed from the playing field and facilities immediately.
4. Only the manager (no coaches or players) shall discuss any plays of controversial nature. The umpire in-chief shall be fully informed of the identity of each team manager.
5. Any batboy/batgirl or ball retriever must wear protective headgear. Bat boys/girls must be prompt in delivering the discarded bats to their proper places.
6. Equipment-hats, gloves, balls, etc. - shall be stacked neatly in their proper places at all times. Discarding bats, gloves, and protective headgear in such a way as to cause personal injury to another player or spectator shall be deemed unsportsmanlike. This can result in an ejection from the game.
7. All Babe Ruth Rules pertaining to bats will be followed. For all Cal Ripken age groups, bats must have the USABat emblem clearly visible. Any bat without the USABat sticker is illegal. For the Babe Ruth 13-15s, bats must have the USABat emblem or the BB-Cor emblem.

General Tournament Guidelines

1. Babe Ruth Baseball rules and regulations will be adhered to during the tournament at all times. Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated and could jeopardize the opportunity for a player or team to proceed in the tournament.
2. Sportsmanship will be stressed at all times. Judgment calls by the umpires will not be questioned. If there is a question concerning a rule, it will be discussed in a gentlemanly manner. Protests will be handled as prescribed in the Babe Ruth Rule Book. Players, managers, coaches and fans will not be allowed to talk to the Protest Committee during protest deliberation unless so asked by the committee.
3. Smoking, chewing tobacco, or drinking of alcoholic beverages by any player, manager, or coach will **NOT** be allowed on the field, or in the dugouts. Teams that allow players to drink beverages or eat food in the dugouts are responsible for cleaning up any debris from such actions immediately after each game.
4. The players, a manager, three coaches and a bat person are the only individuals allowed in the dugout during a game. Any other necessary personnel to be in the dugout will only be allowed with the permission of the State Commissioner.
5. Managers, coaches, and players are to remain in the dugout at all times except when participation in the game or time is called.
6. Teams are not to verbally or in any way harass opposing pitchers, hitters, or defensive players. Encourage your own players and don't make remarks to the opposition. Players should be advised not to argue with umpires. The manager will handle all disputes with the umpire. Encourage positive play at all times!
7. Catchers are required to wear masks and helmets during warm-up both before and during the games. All catchers are to wear protective cups as required. A back-up catcher is to be ready to warm up the pitcher if the catcher is not ready after the end of an inning. Pitchers will be allowed eight (8) pitches between innings and teams have one and one-half minutes to be ready to play between innings. An additional player should be assigned to protect any pitcher warming up while play is going on.
8. No equipment is to be left lying on the field while the game is in progress. It must be in the dugout area.
9. In the case on an injury, the game will be stopped at the earliest possible time. Do not come on to the field until time is called and the umpire signals you to do so.
10. Protective headgear must be worn at bat and on the bases. A mask and throat protector must be worn by any player warming up a pitcher, including in the bullpen. Helmets must also be worn by any bat persons.
11. The home team will occupy the third base dugout.
12. Players, Managers, & Coaches are to shake hands following each game.
13. It is expected that every player, manager, coach and spectator will conduct himself in an exemplary manner while representing the Babe Ruth Baseball Program.

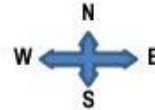

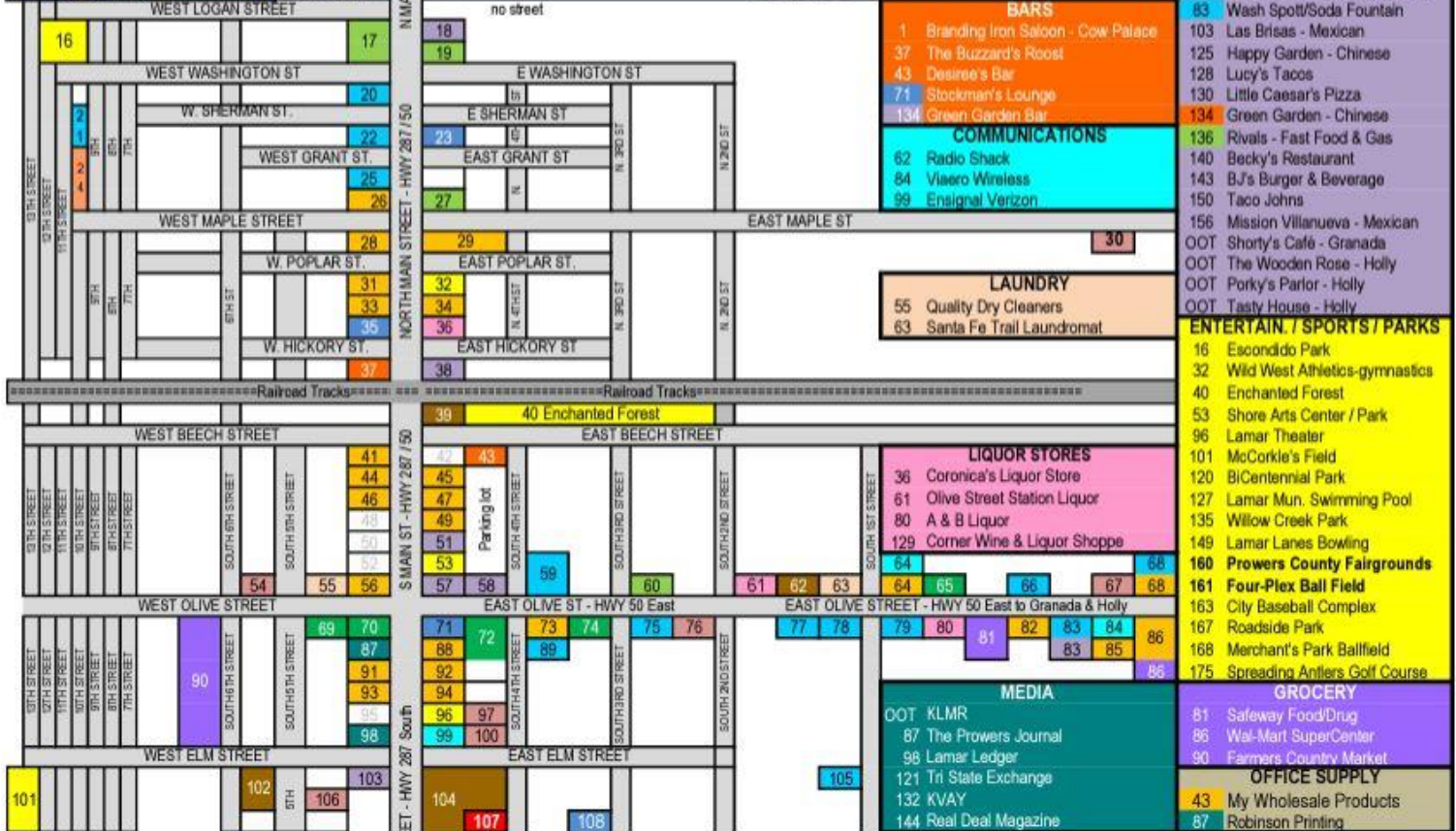

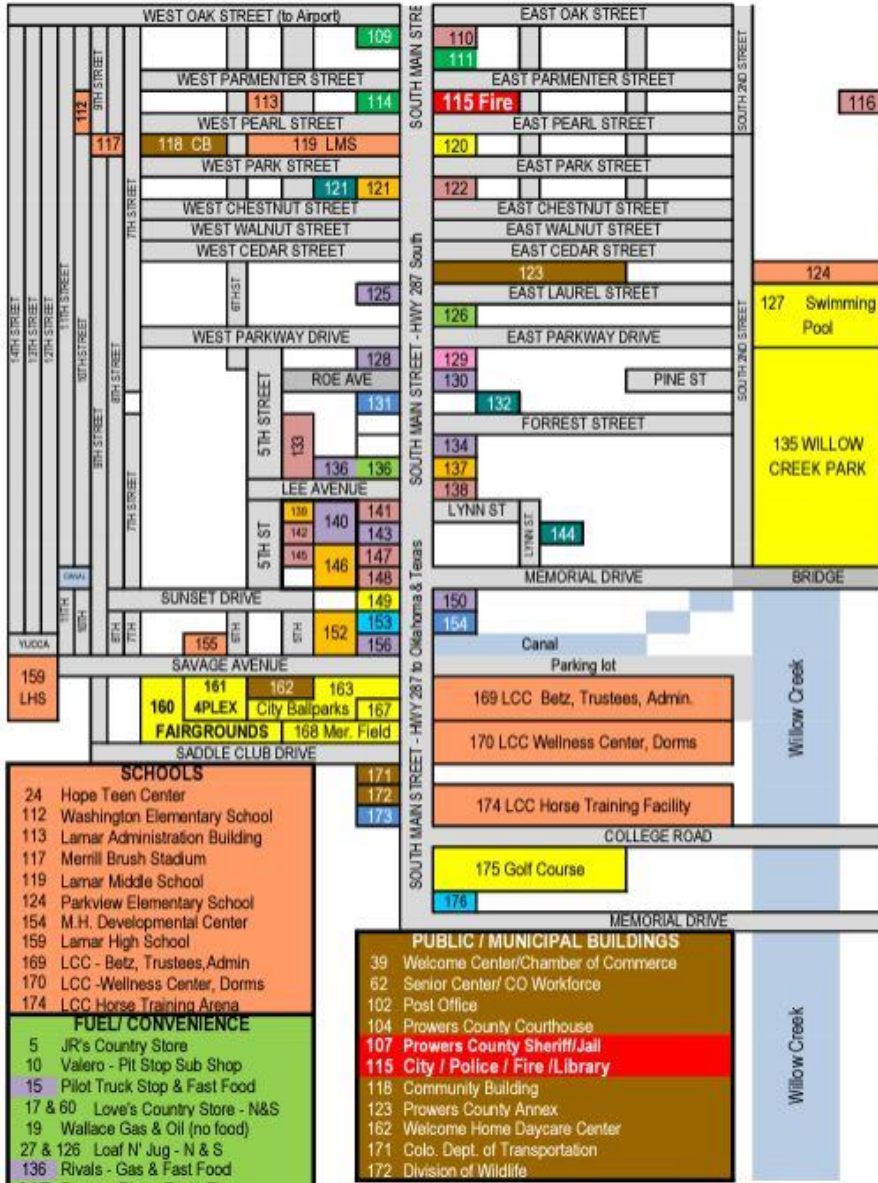
